Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your families are well. We are really looking forward to welcoming some of your children back to school next week and thought it may be helpful to clarify arrangements regarding free school meals and food vouchers as we move into the first phase of schools reopening.

Children in Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5

If your child is in Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 or Year 5 and therefore is **not** returning to school next week in line with government guidance, you will still receive a food voucher each week.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6

If your child **is** returning to school next week, your food voucher will be replaced by the entitlement of a hot meal every day for your child, as before the period of lockdown. This will be the case even if you choose not to have the hot meal and send your child in with a packed lunch.

Children of Key Workers

If your child has been attending school during the lockdown period and has also been receiving a food voucher, this will also be replaced by the entitlement of a hot meal from Monday 8th June.

I hope this makes lunch arrangements clearer moving forward.
