Now write a sentence on how we take turns. Use the pictures to help you.



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


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#### **HANDWRITING**

This week we are looking at letter formation and a list of high frequency words (words that you come across a lot in your reading). See how the letters are formed and practise writing these.




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#### Diversity, Community and Global Project Learning Journey – Wednesday

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


