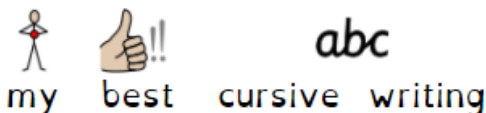
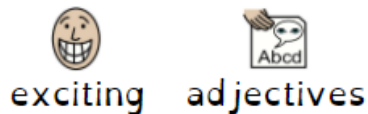
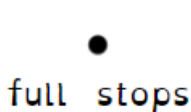

In English, we have been self-assessing our writing.

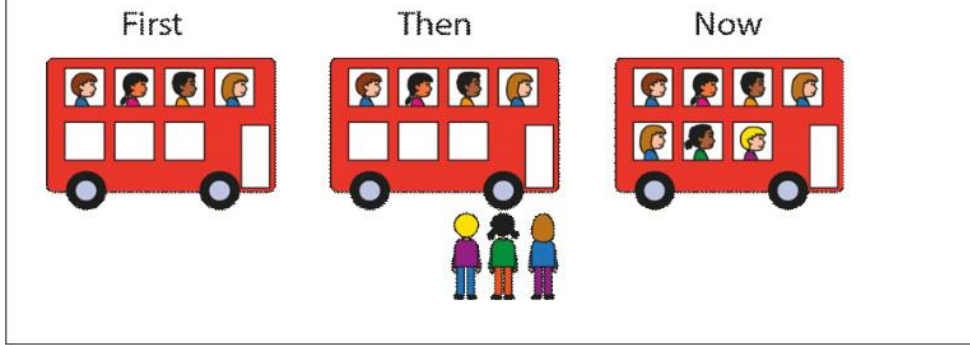


Can you think of how you should improve your writing?

## Maths

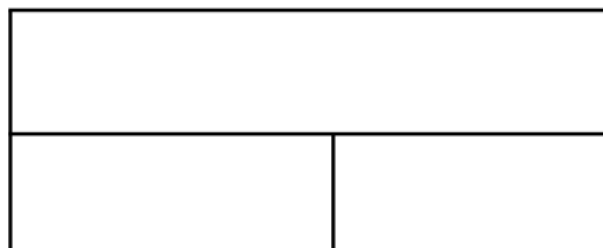
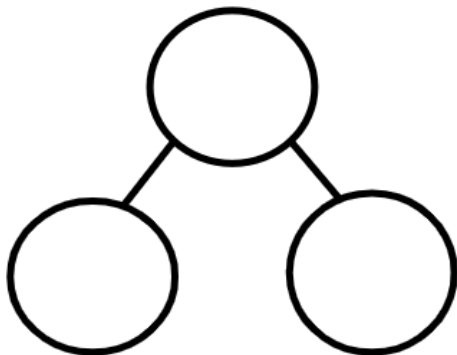
In Maths, we have been looking at number stories. We have been learning how to combine two numbers to add.
