### Remote Learning Feedback and Marking

Dear Parents/Carers,

At West Thornton Primary School, enabling every child to make excellent progress is very important to us and we continuously evaluate what makes the most impact in moving children's learning on.

Following the partial reopening of schools, we have worked together as a staff team to consider the most effective ways to provide feedback to the children when learning remotely.

The purposes of feedback and marking are:-

- To provide useful information which will move the pupil forward in learning
- To promote continuous and focused communication with the pupil
- To encourage high standards in learning

We have outlined the range of strategies that we are using below. There is not an expectation set for the quantity of each strategy your child will receive each week – the class teacher will make a professional judgement based on the needs of your child.

Strategy	What this means for your child
Acknowledgement	Children's work is graded 1,2,3 (1 = met, 2 = partially met, 3 = not yet met) and work returned
Self- assessment	The children reflect on their own learning
Peer – assessment	The children provide feedback to their peers
Written feedback	The children receive a positive comment and misconceptions are addressed
Deep marking	The children's work is annotated and modelled examples are provided to move the children's learning on
Honesty Sheet	The children build their integrity skills by marking their own learning using an answer sheet provided and correcting their errors
Verbal feedback	The children are provided with verbal feedback during Google Meets or interventions set by the teacher.
